## EYFS: Important Updates for Nursery and Reception

Friday 28<sup>th</sup> May

Dear Parent / Carer,

As you are aware there have been some staffing changes in Nursery recently and I wanted to take this opportunity to update you all ahead of the half term break.

Miss Jackson, our nursery teacher, has been on long term leave and will now NOT be returning to nursery for personal reasons. I appreciate this is not an ideal situation and certainly not one we were expecting but Miss Hedley, who will be taking over the class for the rest of the school year, has worked with the children for a while now so she knows our children very well.

Miss West will also be leaving us and will be replaced by Miss Chaters for next half term. There will be some additional adults who will be supporting in nursery next half term too. Miss Ruttley will be joining us each Friday until the end of term. Mrs Wilson, who has been on maternity leave, is currently planning to return for the final three weeks of term and will be supporting our children across the two sessions.

One final piece of information is that our Reception teacher and Early Years Foundation Stage lead, Miss Johnson is going into hospital from Friday 11<sup>th</sup> June and will not return until September. She will be replaced for the rest of the year by Mr Steel who has been supporting and teaching in Reception since January so our children are very familiar with him already.

For those of you returning to nursery in September, we have appointed a new teacher, Miss Wedgwood, who will be supported by Mrs Wilson.

If your child is starting Reception in September, their teacher will be Miss Johnson, supported as ever by Mrs Bonham.

For children moving into Year 1 in September, their teacher will be Mrs Atkinson, supported by Miss Astles.

We will of course provide you with more information ahead of the transition but given all the recent changes we just wanted to update you with this key information in the meantime.
