Fiction

The children will begin by looking at stories with a 'Superhero' theme including 'Superworm and Superfrog'. We will be using 'talk for writing' to innovate our own versions of 'Little Red Riding hood' as well as making predictions around the text, describing settings, recalling key details as well identifying grammar features in the stories and in our writing.

Non Fiction

Children will learn to understand what algorithms are, and how they are implemented as programs. Children will also recognise common uses of information technology beyond school.

Maths

We will be following the 'White Rose' scheme of work focusing on key mathematical areas including fluency, problem solving and reasoning. We will apply these skills to:

- Number and place value
- Addition and subtraction
- Measurement
- Graphs and
- Multiplication and division.

We will also be having daily arithmetic lessons and maths meetings. Children will also be using the Doodle maths app to practise their maths skills.

Science

Children will be taught to work scientifically through the topic of **Animals including humans**.

Children will;

Ask simple questions about the world around them,
Observe closely using simple equipment,
Identify and classify,
Gather and record data to help in answering questions.

Children will learn that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults, and will find out about the basic needs for survival.
