English including Grammar

Children will listen to contemporary fiction, stories which may reflect their own experiences. Children will listen to and write poems which build vocabulary and that have a structure of rhyming couplets. Children will also explore non-fiction, including writing a report and writing and following instructions. Children will take part in a phonics scheme called Read Write Inc. to improve their knowledge of sounds for reading and writing.

Children will continue to learn to leave spaces between words, punctuate sentences using a capital letter and a full stop, question mark or exclamation mark.

Using a capital letter for names of people, places, the days of the week, and the personal pronoun 'I'

Spell and read the age appropriate common exception words.

Science

Animals

Children will be learning to identify a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. Children will learn about carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. Children will learn to describe and compare a variety of common animals. We will also explore animal habitats.

Children will be taught to think scientifically. Experiments and investigations which require the children to predict, explore and conclude will be conducted frequently.

ICT and Computing

Children are continuing to look at algorithms and also how they can use apps within their school work.

PE

The children will be continuing to develop their coordination through athletics.

Art & DT

Children are drawing, painting and making sculptures to develop their imagination.

Music

Children will be appraising songs, singing and making music. Children will also explore a range of instruments.

Mandarin

Children will be working with a specialist Mandarin teacher on a weekly basis.

Mathematics including Arithmetic

Arithmetic, using the +, - and = signs and solving mathematical problems which involve adding and subtracting.

Number and place value, write numbers to and across 50, count, read and write numerals to 50. We will also be looking at multiples of 2, 5 and 10.

Identify one more and one less. Use language of equal to, more and less and start to use symbols for these. Addition and subtraction, addition and subtraction facts within 20. Add and subtract one and two digit numbers including 0.

Measures, exploring capacity and volume, using key vocabulary including full, empty, more than, less than, half, half full, quarter. We will also be looking at length and height, including centimeters and meters.

We follow the White Rose Maths Hub schemes of work.

History & Geography

Children will explore how different methods of communicating have advanced. We will also investigate different ways of travel, and how these methods have evolved through History. Children will compare a typical day now, to what it may have been like 100 years ago. Children will research the country of Peru and compare the similarities and differences between there and the United Kingdom.

RE and PSHCE

Children will be learning about different religions in a weekly assembly and following this up with class work.
