Before your child can take up a place, please be aware of the following points:

- Clubs are NOT offered on a first come, first served basis. Where they are over-subscribed, we will decide how best to allocate the places and we will share our plans accordingly. EVERY child WILL get a place at some point though.
- Payments can not be taken until your child has been offered a place. This will all be organised BEFORE we break up for the half term holidays.
- Arrangements must be made for your child to be collected at 4:30pm from the main entrance by an adult. Children cannot walk home on their own from clubs nor will they be able to attend clubs if no proper arrangement for collection is made.
- Once a place is offered, payment must be made before your child can start the club.
- Every child joining an after-school club needs to have a behaviour contract signed by their parent / carer before they can start too.
- We had such a huge take up for Cookery Club in September that it has taken us until Easter to get everyone in. We are now offering this club to **other** children from Year 3 to Year 6 who have **not** done cookery this year and would like to give it a try. Please **do not** sign up your child if they have done it already this school year.

At £10 per half term it represents incredible value for money in terms of after school care but our primary purpose of running them is to give our children as many rich experiences in school as we possibly can. We look forward to seeing our children having a wonderful time.
