Subject	What we will know
English	Talk for Writing Autumn 1 - Cross curricular writing with History, the children will be learning about The Battle of Britain and will write a letter of persuasion to persuade men/women to join up for the war. Autumn 1 - Using The story of Kidnapped the children will write a fictional tale that includes a flashback. Autumn 2 - Using the text The Canal, the children will compose a tale of fear. Autumn 2 - The children will be looking at a selection of autobiographies and will write an autobiography on a person of their choice.

Geography	<u>Climate Change</u> Changes in weather around the world, global warming, greenhouse gases, flooding and flood prevention.

History	World War Two- The Battle of Britain Why did Britain face an invasion in June 1940? Interpret numerical and written evidence about Hitler. How did Britain win and why? Describe and explain reasons why King John signed the Magna Carta in 1215. Why is this an important turning point in British history?
Design & Technology	Structures Use A wide range of methods and tools to stiffen, strengthen and reinforce complex structures.
Art & Design	Autumn 1 - Digital Art Banksy (Cross curricular with art) Replicating the artist, study his inspiration and his life. Autumn 2- Print and Textiles Kathe Kollwitz Replicating the artist, study her inspiration and her life.

RE	<u>Christianity</u> - Christian terms and concepts. The challenges facing Christians in the contemporary world. Empathy and reflection in the Christian faith.
PSHCE	Being in My World - Goals, dreams, and aspirations. To know about children's rights and the UN. The role of democracy and how to contribute to a democratic process. How do you feel valued? How to ensure others feel valued and respected. How to regulate your emotions and understand the emotions of others. To know that your choices have a consequence and that your actions can have an affect on the well being of others.
PE	Athletics Sprinting, hurdles, vertical high jumps javelin. Team Games - Hitting, fielding, hand eye coordination with throwing and catching, develop spacial awareness. Be able to attack and defend.
