Year 5

Subject	What we will know ...
English	<p><u>Fiction</u> We will be looking at a range of defeating the monster texts and focussing on innovating Beowulf. We will explore the magical fantasy world of Harry Potter and look at how he defeated the monsters he is faced with as well as innovating a losing tale.</p> <p><u>Non-Fiction</u> We will be creating our own persuasive adverts to encourage people to visit Hogwarts. For our instructional texts we will be creating 'How to keep a dragon amused.'</p>
Mathematics	We will be focussing on basic skills initially followed by number and place value. We will look at measures as well as continuing to develop our times tables knowledge. We will be building upon or calculation methods and looking at the four operations.
Science	This term, we will look at Earth and Space followed by a study of Forces.
Computing	We will be learning about collaboration and app design as well as programming robots with Lego EV3.

Geography	Our focus will be on volcanoes this term. How they are formed and where they are in the world.
History	Our focus will be on the Mayan civilization this term.
Design & Technology	Our focus for the Design and Technology fortnight this term will be based around structures.
Art & Design	We will be looking at the artists Gunta Stolz and Henry Moore; with a focus on print, textiles and collage.
MFL	We will be continuing learning French. We will recap the months of the year, seasons and modes of transport. We will look at dates and look at our journey to school. We will recap school items and learn subjects.
Music	In music we will be playing the ukulele, working on playing together in time. We will learn a famous pop song, as well as chord changes. We will also be learning and performing our Christmas performance.
RE	We will focus on Christianity and Buddhism.
PSHCE	We will looking at the area 'Being me in my World' this term.
PE	We will be developing our athletics skills as well as our team game sports.
Trips	We hope to visit the Hatton Art Gallery this term.
