This is to encourage the eventual development of safe and healthy relationships in later life. The unit will develop understanding and attitudes which will help pupils to form relationships in a responsible and healthy manner and to appreciate the value of stable family life, including the responsibilities of parenthood and marriage.

This until will therefore include age-appropriate sex education, to ensure children are prepared for the changes adolescence brings which will draw on knowledge of the human life cycle as set out in the National Curriculum for Science.
