#### Fiction

### **Non Fiction**

We will create a non-chronological report about a wild animal. We will look at the features to include and research a range of facts to put in to a formal report.

## **Spellings and Grammar**

We will be focusing on fronted adverbials, relative clauses, the use of dialogue in stories and pronouns. We will continue with our weekly spellings for homework, looking for patterns and new sounds to learn.

All children in year 4 will now write with a pen. We will have regular handwriting sessions to develop a cursive continuous style. Reading

## Mathematics

## Multiplication and division

We will know our times tables up 12 x 12 and related division facts.

Learn how to use the grid method and progress this to using short multiplication.

We will continue to use games and times tables rock stars to enjoy learning and challenging ourselves to learn our times tables.

## **Fractions**

We will look at equivalents, adding and subtracting fractions, understanding that fractions are part of a whole and begin to link them to decimal equivalents.

## Spring 1- Electricity

- identify common appliances that run on electricity
- construct a simple series electrical circuit, identifying and naming its basic parts, including cells, wires, bulbs, switches and buzzers
- identify whether or not a lamp will light in a simple series circuit, based on whether or not the lamp is part of a complete loop

Computing	We will be learning how to code using various Apps. In particular we will use Tynker and SEESAW. We will become proficient in recording our work and will look at using iMovie to make adverts.
Geography	Volcanoes We will look at the following skills:  • Understanding the effect of the landscape features on the development of the locality.  • Describe how people have been affected by changes in the environment.  • Describe how people have differing qualities of life living in different locations and environments
History	We will be finding out what life was like for children during World War 2 and focusing particularly on life in Wallsend during this time. We will do this by:  Research what it was like for children in a given period from the past and use photographs and illustrations to present their findings  Describe events from the past according to the different periods of time when they happened (BC, AD, decade, century)  Use a timeline within a specific time in history to set out the order things may have happened.
Design & Technology	This term our focus is electrical systems: how to use them and looking at electrical systems in products. We will be designing and making a toy that a child may have had during WW2. The skills we will work on are:  • Creating designs using exploded diagrams  • Use a wide range of materials and plan how to use them.  • Use techniques which require accuracy to cut, shape, join and finish.
Art & Design	Our Focus for Spring 1 will be painting. We will learn new skills by: creating different effects by using a variety of tools and techniques such as washes, scratches and splashes. We will be creating a 'layered' effect to showcase these techniques. We will also look at using a variety of other techniques eg. marbelling, silkscreen and colour wash in our painting.
