| English  | Mathematics   |
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| This half term, we are reading 'Arthur and The Golden Rope' and writing a similar short story about 'defeating a beast'! Our non-fiction unit will include writing a non-chronological report about a terrifying monster.  | This half term we will continue to look at 'Addition and Subtraction' and becoming fluent in using these operations with 3-digit numbers. We will then move on to 'Multiplication and Division'.  |
| Art & Design   | Computing   |
| This half term we will be painting! We will be exploring warm and cold colours and tones, as well as learning about mixing complimentary colours. We will also be looking at the artist 'Henri Rousseau' and how he used paints effectively.   | In Computing, we are learning how to use email! We will learn about input and output devices, before looking at computer networks and how they share information. We will also learn how to use software to accomplish our goals.                             |
| Design & Technology  | Geography   |
| Our topic this half term is 'Food and Nutrition'. We will be learning how to identify different food groups and understand the origins of our food. We will also be able to explore our nutritional skills in the cooking room while making tarts and crumble.   | This half term in our Geography lessons we will be looking at the topic 'Counties and Cities of the UK', looking at features, landscapes, rivers, seas, and cities. We will be using observation and comparison skills to understand the geography of the UK. |
| History  | Music   |
| Next half term we will be continuing our journey through history by learning about the Iron Age. We will continue to discuss how human life developed through time. We will also learn how these changes impacted our lives today.   | This half term we will be learning about the chime bars, looking at notation, rhythm reading and accuracy in playing. We will also be celebrating the Winter period with some festive songs!  |
| Personal Social Health & Economic education (PSHE)   | Physical Education (PE)   |
| Our topic for the second part of the Autumn term is 'Celebrating Differences'. We will be discussing conflicts in friendship groups and at home and discussing strategies that can be used to help solve these situations.   | In P.E this term our topic will be 'Gymnastics', through this we will be composing a movement sequence both independently and with others. We will create and learn different ways to travel, pose and jump.  |
| Religious Education (RE)   | Science   |
| Our Autumn focus for this half term is 'Advent'. Through this we will learn about the symbol of the advent ring and the season of Advent, while learning about how this season is celebrated in different countries.   | We are continuing our 'Rocks, Soils and Fossils' unit with a focus on Fossils and the wonderful palaeontologists that have existed through history. We will be looking at different kinds of fossils and discussing what they can teach us about the past.    |
| In KS2 we learn French in our Modern Foreign Languages Curriculum (MFL)  |   |
| In our French lessons this half term we will be continuing with our 'All About Me' topic. We are continuing to learn vocabulary that we can use to introduce ourselves, alongside learning the numbers 0 -20, the colours, and the months of the year in order to share our birthday in French. We continue to use our conversational skills to ask and answer simple questions about ourselves, alongside recapping skills from memory. |   |
