Our systems have been working very well but parents are still congregating around the school premises. It is our firm advice that you remain 2m apart and leave immediately after dropping off / collecting your child. You will notice that staff wear visors and face masks at these times and we would be very supportive of any parents and carers who wished to do the same.

As you will no doubt be aware, Breakfast Club and our after-school provision are something we value enormously. Unfortunately, we still won't be able to offer either of these next half term. We will continue to review and risk assess and perhaps in the new year the picture will change and we will be able to resume these invaluable opportunities for our children and their families.
